

## EDITORIAL.

Yet again the newsletter is late, but this is purely down to, the editor obtaining a new computer, and most of my spare time organising the 1995 UFO Conference.

The Roswell film allegedly showing the autopsy of one of the aliens recovered from the Roswell crash is bubbling along at the moment and appears to be in the forefront of British Ufology at present. In Maria wards current newsletter Circles Research March 95, Maria updates us on the incident. She says that the autopsy takes place in a 'BARN', and the two doctors are removing armfuls of intestine. There is also discrepancy in dates, as the film is dated some 18-25 days after the alleged incident, and the 30.7.47. I cannot comprehend an autopsy being carried out in a barn under such unhygienic circumstances. I am aware, that the debris was flown out almost as soon as the crash had been discovered, and therefore, why not fly the bodies out as well. There are witnesses to the effect that the army at the time wanted caskets the size of children. I wonder why, if not to transport the recovered bodies to an unknown, heavily guarded base, to a proper mortuary, where a full autopsy could be carried out.

In the Independent newspaper of the 29th March 1995, Mr Philip Mantle of BUFORA, writes 'It shows a scene in the desert', 'Two men in white coats (Surely they are wearing some kind of protective clothes ie face masks, rubber gloves !!) (It sounds a bit as if these two men dressed in white should be on a funny farm, and not carrying out an autopsy..!!!), are taking 'Samples and inspecting something on a bench' (What about the intestines Phil, or is it just sausages from the local butchers I hear you ask?). Then in an interview in the Daily Mail on the 28th March 1995, Mr Mantle states that the film shows 'The inside of a 'temporary' structure, a tent of some kind - in the desert, lit by 'Lamps not electricity'. 'The two men in white coats appear to be taking 'Tissue samples' (By the handful it seems !!!!!).

I still cannot comprehend the archaic way these alleged bodies were treated. Surely, the military have electric generators that could provide electric lighting (Next we will be told that the MIW's (Men In White), wore miners helmets with lamps on to see what they were doing).

I feel we have not heard the last of this film footage, and all I can say is, buyers beware, you may get your fingers burnt. I also see that the footage is to be shown at the BUFORA conference in August in Sheffield. This 87 minute film is to be released on the 19th April 1995, with an 18 certificate (My 2 copies must of had the naughty bits cut out... Just my luck!!!!). Calling all earthlings - prepare for an out-of-this world experience at a Hampshire conference .

UFO spotters worldwide will be converging on a Hampshire school for a meeting organised by Southampton expert Steve Gerrard.

Steve,32,has become a worldwide celebrity in the closely-knit circle of UFO watchers.

The part-time policeman runs Southampton UFO Group,whose soaring membership includes fanatics throughout Europe and America.

International phone calls and letters arrive daily at his Woolston semi,crammed with 7,500 press cuttings,300 books and over 150 videos of flying phenomena.

An extra terrestrial sighting over Southampton Water in 1985 launched Steve into his extra-terrestrial hobby.

"A big ball of orange light appeared over Hythe - it just hung in the sky,and then it moved as though it was going down a flight of stairs," said the father of two.

Bust most strange sightings have a terrestrial answer explained Steve,a computer terminal operator with Hampshire Police.

"Ninety-six per cent of all sightings can be explained - but it's the four per cent that you can't put an answer to that we're interested in," said the special constable who patrols a footbeat in Netley,"I think there is a form of life out there that may be trying to make contact with us.

"The government is aware of this,but they're covering it up because of the panic it would cause," said Steve,of Weston Grove Road.

The conference lifts off at Warblington Secondary School, Portsmouth,on April 22.

I received a letter from Chester Grusinski from Michigan, who related to me the events of a UFO sighting from the USS Franklin D. Roosevelt aircraft carrier in 1958. The ship was on a shake down cruise near Gitmo, Cuba when this cigar shaped object with a row of windows came up to our ship. It had figures inside watching our ship. Then it turned a red-orange colour. (This is when I could see its cigar shape, because it was dark outside). It took off, up very fast. Bridge watch was screaming on the ships intercom for the officer of the deck or bridge to get up on the double. The ships manoeuvres stopped suddenly for some unknown reason.
