EDITORIAL.

URGENT ... URGENT ... URGENT  
CHANGE TO GROUP MEETING VENUE  
READ ON.....

*How the mighty fall are words that flashed across my mind when I read in the June edition of Area S1 published by the Sheffield UFO Research Association. In the World UFO Newsround Section was a sub heading 'Mantle Stands Down'. It appears that Mr Philip Mantle, former Director Of Investigations for BUFORA has relinquished his post. Mr Mantle had deposited a number of photographs with a picture agency that were already copy righted by other researchers, authors etc. But the only problem was, Mr Mantle did not have the authority do this, thus possibly breaching copy right laws. None of the photos belonged to BUFORA and it appeared that Mr Mantle had acted on his own on this matter. But a Ufologist, realised that a picture that was copy righted to himself appeared in a national newspaper and that the article said the copy right belonged to the picture agency. Obviously the UFO researcher complained to the newspaper concerning the copyright of the picture and Mr Mantle was now in serious trouble and there was only one avenue of escape in my view and that was to resign his position within BUFORA as Director Of Investigations. The magazine goes on to state that Mr Mantle will 'Be putting Ufology on the back burner to spend more time with his family'. I feel that this was only one of a number of things that Mr Mantle has been recently involved in that has dented his credibility as a UFO Researcher (i.e. The Roswell Footage and internal wranglings within BUFORA over the resignation of Jenny Randles). The new Director of Investigations is to be Gloria Dixon, and like the Sheffield UFO Research Association, I wish her well in her new position and I hope that she brings a new stability to the group.*

*Roswell will never die it seems, as it appears that someone has handed a UFO organisation alleged material that came from the crashed object at Roswell. Strange that this 'wreckage' has appeared following the release of the alleged 'Roswell Autopsy'. More on this story later, but I feel that this could be yet another red herring and the truth will come out sooner rather than later.*

*I would like to welcome aboard Mr Ernie Sears, who will be taking some of the strain off my shoulders by reviewing the magazines that I receive each month. SIGHTINGS, is another that is newish, glossy, mail order at £25 for 12 issues from Rapide Publishing, 14a Union Street, Newton Abbot, Devon, TQ12 2JS, packed full of British abduction incidents, Roswell, which won't lie down!, latest "alien" movie "Independence Day", interview with Jacques Vallee, Astronauts alien experiences, Nick Pope interview, etc, another good buy.

ENCOUNTERS still going strong, still a bit too "sensational", even if it specialises in the entire paranormal field, this issue its mainly ghosts, ie; Borley Rectory, Menwith Hill in depth, Chingle Hall, that Solway "spaceman" photo and the connection with Woomera Space Station, Celebrity UFO Encounters, Portsmouth Poltergeist, etc etc, £2.99 in the shops.

World UFO Journal..small "donations only" 23 page magazine, sightings, items worldwide, "Giant UFO" (or maybe THAT huge comet!) making impact 1997, Patrick Moore says 'not to worry'!, produced singlehandedly by Editor Edward Harris, 16 Newton Green, Dunmow, Essex, CM6 1DU, a dedicated gentleman indeed!

AREA S1, Sheffield UFO Research Association's mag, packed with very small print articles, current "triangles". Kirtland AirForce Base info, Jenny Randles UFO "chase" article, World events, "build your own UFO Detector"!, interesting and worth the £1 a copy, from 87 Hawley Street, Sheffield, S1 2EA.

UFO NETWORK NATIONWIDE U.K...20 pages, small mag, small print, UFO photos, news cuttings, sightings, neatly packaged, £1 per copy, bi-monthly, contact 88 Whincover Drive, Old Farnley, Leeds, LS12 5JT, West Riding, Yorks.

COVERUP, from the Lothian Unexplained Phenomena Research, seven page A4 mag, photos, cuttings, sightings, Spiritual Internet, Leeds Lectures, Bigfoot, Rats (?), Chinese scene, USA, (Man conceals snake in his underwear?) etc. Is nothing sacred? BSE, etc etc. £1 an issue from David Colman but nowhere is there an address or 'phone number!

A CLOSE ENCOUNTER WITH NICK POPE! by ERNIE SEARS

The ex-"UFO EXPERT" who has held down a desk at the Ministry of Defence for three years and holds the equivalent rank of an Army Major attracted a queue outside of Dillons Southampton bookshop by the time I arrived at 6.30 on the evening of June 10th, the Daily Mail excerpts from his book, "Open Skies, Closed Minds" (£14.99 from Dillons and countrywide outlets) and the UFO grapevine etc saw to that!

Nearly 200 people packed the shop foyer by the time Nick was introduced to us by Dillons store manager, and what a gripping talk our very own "Fox Mulder," as the media have labelled him, gave to us.

A quietish but forceful man, Nick Pope outlined his years at The Ministry, and, although ensuring that he told us the views he had were personal and not "official", (did we note that tongue in the cheek?), the anecdotes, followed by some interesting slides, had the majority of us enthralled..even yours truly, involved for some fifty years in "our subject", learnt new ones!

Massive queues formed afterwards, to purchase the book, and to chat with Nick. He gave his time generously to the mainly intelligent questions asked, too, and I was lucky enough, having missed my later 'bus and having an hour to spare, to be introduced to Nick by his publishers representative, once I'd mentioned the Southampton UFO group and a couple of my own experiences. I learnt of Nicks next book, concerning the paranormal aspects of contactees, percipients, and abductees, a field I'm very conversant with!

As for "Open Skies, Closed Minds", I sat up late that night and the next one, concluding that Nick Pope, obviously writing with "authority" due to his MOD post, comes down firmly on the "alien" answers, and has achieved a step forward into the next really BIG step, which many of us feel is "just around the corner", the "lid" being gradually lifted into whatever scenario we are going to find ourselves in, hopefully more prepared than in the past! Nick Pope is right at the cutting edge of this still enigmatic mystery. The book covers much that is already known, and much that reveals the "inside story" behind it, and he is to be congratulated for not only inspiring those who have been "involved" for many years, but for opening further, the minds of those, like the young "student" types present at the meeting, who are aware of the subject and eager to know more.

We are all aware of the peril our planet is in, and somehow, somewhere, we are also aware of the concern felt from, "out there"? Nick Popes book can only be a positive step towards a positive solution.


