UFO TYPES

In order to differentiate concisely but adequately between the many ufo shapes and types reported in 1974-1975, the following catalogue describes and (for future reference) codes the various forms presently recognized by Data Research. These codes appear in several of the summaries and analyses, detailed on later pages and have been segregated into common (or comparatively common) types and less common (or rare) types.

Common or Comparatively Common TypesBrief Description of TypeCode.

- 1a Flat Disc: round, domeless.
 1b " ": multisided, domeless.
 1c " ": round, centrally domed. Domes variable in size.
 1d Dustbin-lid shaped: round, sub-pyramidal, usually domeless.
 2 Hats shaped: central "cabin" vertically cylindrical (but often rounded on top) encircled ventrally by a flat rim or flange.
 3a Bowl or Dish shaped: round, domeless.
 3b " " " ": round, domed, or sometimes with central "spindle" like device.
 4 Saucer shaped: round, centrally domed. Domes variously proportioned.
 5a Double-saucer shaped: round, slightly convex units, joined peripherally.
 5b " " " ": round, markedly convex units, similarly joined.
 6 Rugby-ball shaped: domeless.
 6a " " " ": centrally domed. Domes usually small or very small.
 6b " " " ": with small lateral fins.
 7 Saturn-like: encircling flange joined to main orb-shaped body of object.
 8a Sphere or Globe: plain surfaced. Sometimes with "ports" or apertures.
 8b " " " ": surface panelled or segmented.
 8c " " " ": tailed. Tails of various shapes and lengths.
 8d " " " ": domed. Domes usually very small; can be situated on both the top and under sides of main body of object.
 8e Sphere: winged.
 8f Sphere: with "feet".
 9 Egg-shaped:
 10 "Round": a blanket description. Either types 1a to 4 viewed full-face, or an indistinct manifestation of type 8a.
 11 Elliptical or "Oval": either that shape, or oblique views of types 1a-5a.
 11a "Oval": has body transversely bisected by a bar-like structure.
 12 Pyramidal: pitch to apex variable (possibly a variant of type 1d).
 13a Cone shaped: one end rounded. Often described as bullet-like or shell-like (military, not molluscan, shells are meant here).
 13b " ": as type 13a, but with one end pointed.
 14a Rocket-like: single or multi-finned.
 14b " ": finless.
 15 Arrow shaped: length variable. Shaft or stem sometimes very short.
 16 Torpedo shaped: (including those forms described as "sausage"-like).
 17a Cigar shaped: (including those forms described as dirigible shaped).
 17b " ": dorsally domed.
 17c " ": domed dorsally and ventrally.
 18a Cylinder shaped: diameter uniform throughout length (including forms described as "cigarette"-like or pole shaped).
 18b " ": wholly or partially tapered.
 18c Funnel-like or Bell-shaped: may be an acute variant of type 18b.
 19 Rod-like: usually very thin and sometimes very long (possibly a variant of type 18a).
 20 Bar shaped: lengths and thicknesses highly variable.
 21 Barrel shaped:

- 23 Humming or Spinning-Top shaped:
- 24 Mushroom shaped:
- 24a " " : inverted position (may be connected with type 3b)
- 25 Doughnut shaped: diameter of central hole variable.
- 26a Ring shaped: single.
- 26b " " : double or multiple.
- 26c Coil or Spring shaped:
- 27a Wheel shaped: spoked.
- 27b " " : cogged. Objects described as jagged-edged discs are included in this category.
- 28 Spindle-shaped:
- 29 Cross shaped: possibly a variant of type 14a.
- 30 Multi-armed: generally a small central orb having three or more radiating arm-like structures, often independently movable.
- 31 Tentacled: generally a small central orb with flexible "arms" or antennae.
- 32a Crescent shaped:
- 32b V-shaped or Boomerang shaped: (excluding V-shaped formations of lights).
- 32c D-shaped or Heel-shaped:
- 32d Delta-Wing shaped: occasionally with a short fuselage.
- 41a* Flat Triangle: domeless.
- 41b " " : domed. Domes usually very small; number and positions of same variable.
- 42 Diamond or Lozenge shaped: nearly always domeless and usually flat.
- 43 Oblong shaped: flat.
- 44a Square or Rectangular in shape: flat.
- 44b " " " " : six-sided or open box-like.
- 45 Diffuse or Cloud-like: believedly connected with one or more solid objects obscured within. Cases are known where solid objects entered or emerged from erratically (also stationary) moving cloud-like masses.
- 46 Globular Lights: probably solid objects obscured by luminosity.
- 46a " " : tailed; may be identical with type 49.
- 47 Star like: probably solid objects obscured by luminosity.
- 48 Flare-like:
- 49 Tadpole shaped: may be connected with type 46a.
- 50 Squiggly shaped or "blobs of light": highly flexible objects, often altering shape continuously.

Uncommon and Rare Types

- 51 Railway-carriage shaped: (minus wheels).
- 52 Jeep-like (minus wheels): occasionally with a central turret.
- 53 Bootee shaped: may be connected with type 50 (see Stanway and Pace, 1968. "Flying Saucer Report: UFOs Unidentified, Undeniable", p.11).
- 54 House or Haystack shaped: apparently a roofed-in boxlike form.
- 55 Generator-like:
- 56 Triglobular:
- 56a Bi-Globular: so far known only as small-sized objects.
- 57 Grid like: can be square, round, closed peripherally, or open bordered.
- 58 Twin or multi-tailed: body usually oval or spherical, with two or more tails.
- 59 Irregularly shaped: objects of solid construction but conforming to no describable shape. Possibly these indeterminate shapes are more a result of poor eyewitness reporting.
- 60 S-shaped: has been observed in both the normal and reverse position.
- 61 Hook-shaped: very rare.
- 62 Dumb-bell shaped:
- 62a Jelly-bean shaped:

* Numbers 33 to 40 inclusive are reserved for future classifications.

- 63 Bird shaped (not "Mothman"): usually gigantic, solid body of a general avian configuration, with huge moveable "wings" (see Fort, Wilkins, et al, for interesting reports of this UFO type).
- 64 Propeller shaped: has three equally spaced, curved propeller-like flanges round a disc shaped or globular shaped central body.
- 65 Concentrated Beams of non-dispersive light: sources undiscernible.
- 66 Bobbin shaped:

- 68 Heart shaped: possibly a variant of type 22 or type 76.
- 69 Circular shaped central body: with cone-like ventral structure, and triangular shaped superstructure.
- 70 Hemispherical: sometimes with a retractable ventral tube or cylinder.

- 72 Bottle shaped: with encircling flange at or near base.
- 73 Mouth-organ shaped: straight.
- 73a " " " : Curved.
- 74 Jagged-edged disc: Probably connected with type 27b, and possibly a variant of types 24 or 24a, or both.

- 77 Slug shaped: generally of large size; has small vertical tail fins.
- 78 Umbrella shaped: may be a variant of types 24 or 24a, or both.

- 83 Pseudoplane: superficially resembling conventional aircraft, but proportions and performance impossible for same.

The foregoing list of UFO Types has been compiled from those previously published issues of the UFO Register. In addition to the above types a further 5 types not directly classifiable with the foregoing catalogue, were reported during 1974 and 1975. They are defined below.

VEHICLE INTERFERENCE CASES FOR 1974-1975

By D.N. MANSELL

Vehicle interference is usually put down to electro magnetic effects, whether this is true no one knows, it could well be a force field unknown to us. However we do know that vehicles have been effected very badly, when a UFO has been in close proximity.

The effects on vehicles and occupants are numerous, as seen by the catalogue, the most common being, engine failure, headlight and radio failure. As for the occupants, they suffer from shock, fear, electric shocks and some are paralysed. Cars have been taken over by some other force and driven for many miles, occupants included.

Vehicle interference seems to occur in any country, some of the countries involved being: Belgium, United States, Spain, Zimbabwe, Australia, England, Denmark, New Zealand and Brazil, but in other years, cases occur all over the globe, in the air and at sea.

It is noteworthy that in many of the 1974-75 cases, occupants were seen in many of the UFOs, here are a few examples:- three humanoids, in one piece suits, walking like robots:- large humanoid figure, wearing a suit like a divers, had a light on his collar:- ten small humanoids, about 3½ feet tall emerged from one craft and collected soil samples:- on others, types of robots have been seen near the craft.

Various coloured lights have been seen on the craft, ranging between, red, green, blue, gold, white and multicoloured, it should be noted, several of the craft have had a blue glow surrounding them.

Not included in vehicle interference, are vehicles and craft which disappear, usually in front of other witnesses. Several occurred during 1974 and 1975, perhaps the most noteworthy case, being a British police car chase. The patrol car, a Ford Granada, was about to pull up a Ford Cortina for speeding. The police crew, a Sergeant and Constable, had taken the number of the Cortina and with flashing lights pulled along side, instantly the Cortina, a black one and its one male occupant, disappeared before their eyes. The police sergeant, was off sick for 3½ months, the constable for 5 months, neither would go on that stretch of road again, incidently, the registration number did not exist. No names or area can be given for obvious reasons. Cases have occurred like this, in several parts of the world, including the Soviet Union and really, they are a type of vehicle interference, perhaps not an electro magnetic one.

I hope this brief article, will help readers understand a little more about vehicle interference and what it involves.

LANDINGS

As you can see by the catalogue, there have not been a great number of landings during 1974 and 1975, but it must be remembered, we can only list those we receive, there must be many more reported to various organisations around the world.

However, of the landings reported, there are many noteworthy cases. During 1974 there were twelve cases, which involved entities seen by witnesses, this is

one example:

On January 7th at Warneton in Belgium, the witness was driving his car, when the engine, radio and headlights failed. He then noticed a craft, with tripod legs, resting in a field. Two humanoids walked over to his car, while the third stood by the object, the figures were wearing one piece suits and walked not unlike robots. The witness felt a shock at the back of his head and heard a modulated sound, they then returned to the craft, it took off and disappeared.

DATA RESEARCH FILES:-

In 1975, again there were twelve cases involving entities, with several very good cases coming out of Norway, these are not included in the catalogue, as they are still under investigation. For 1975, we have given typical landing example, without entities involved:-

In July a family near Hobart, Tasmania, Australia, were travelling in their car, when the interior suddenly became hot and the engine stalled. They saw an object about 200-300 metres ahead of them, hovering just off the road. The craft was 4-5 metres in width, was round and luminous, it took off after a couple of minutes.

ANIMAL REACTION

DURING THE RECENT YEARS OF UFO INVESTIGATION, SEVERAL INCIDENTS HAVE BEEN CLOSELY RELATED TO THE THEORY OF SUPERNATURAL SENSITIVITY AMONG ANIMALS. THEIR SENSORY POWERS ARE FAR IN EXCESS OF ANYTHING HUMANS POSSESS. FOR EXAMPLE, THE MIGRATORY HABITS OF BIRDS IN RELATION TO THE EARTH'S MAGNETIC PULL, OR THE RADAR-LIKE HEARING OF BATS.

ONE OF THE FIRST INDICATIONS OF UFO ACTIVITY IS THE DISTRESS OF ANIMALS, EITHER THE RESTLESSNESS OF CATTLE, THE CAREERING OF HORSES OR THE EXCITED BARKING OF DOGS. OF THE LEAST INTELLIGENT ANIMAL, A ROMANIAN FARMER IN 1967 SAW ALL HIS CHICKENS IN HIS FARMYARD RUNNING TOWARDS HIM VISIBLY TERRIFIED AND CACKLING LIKE LUNATICS, A METALLIC SILVERY DISC WAS CLEARLY SEEN ABOVE. ANOTHER WITNESS DESCRIBING A HIGH-PITCHED WHISTLING SOUND WHEN A UFO LANDED, NOTICED HOW STILL EVERYTHING BECAME, NO BIRDS SINGING, NO INSECT SOUNDS, EVEN THE COWS IN THE FIELD APPEARED MOTIONLESS, AND AS HE TRIED TO APPROACH THE OBJECT WAS HIMSELF UNABLE TO MOVE A MUSCLE, AS IF PARALYSED.

DOGS CAN, IT SEEMS SENSE THE APPROACH OF UFOs BEFORE HUMANS, THE DETECTION COULD BE BASED ON VIBRATIONS, KEENER HEARING OR ACUTE SENSE OF SMELL. ONE WITNESS TAKING HIS DOG FOR A WALK VISITED A SITE WHERE HE BELIEVED A UFO HAD LANDED, THE DOG SNIFFED THE AREA, GAVE OUT A HOWL AND RAN HOME. (THERE ARE MANY CASES OF UFOs AND ACRID SMELLS). THE OWNER SAID HIS DOG TREMBLED FOR DAYS AND WAS RELUCTANT TO GO OUT UNTIL A VERY HEAVY RAINSTORM SWEEPED THE AREA AND PRESUMABLY WASHED THE SMELL AWAY AND THE DOG BEHAVED NORMALLY AGAIN. DOGS HAVE BEEN KNOWN TO HOWL, RAISE HACKLES, EVEN CRAWL AWAY IN FEAR IN CONJUNCTION WITH SIGHTINGS.

OUT OF THE MANY CASES STUDIED AND THE LIST IS EXTREMELY LONG, ONE STARTLING FACT IS REVEALED AND THAT IS THEY ALL DISPLAYED SYMPTOMS OF EXTREME FEAR AND PANIC AT THE APPROACH OF A UFO.

1975 ABDUCTION

PERHAPS ONE OF THE MOST FAMOUS ABDUCTION CASES WHICH WAS WIDELY PUBLICIZED IN 1975 WAS THAT OF TRAVIS WALTON. MANY BOOKS HAVE BEEN WRITTEN ABOUT IT, INCLUDING AN AUTO-BIOGRAPHY.

TRAVIS WALTON WAS A MEMBER OF A SEVEN MAN WOODCUTTING TEAM WHICH HAD A GOVERNMENT CONTRACT TO CLEAR AWAY BRUSHWOOD IN THE APACHE-SITGREAVES NATIONAL PARK IN ARIZONA. U.S.A. AFTER A DAY'S WORK THE TEAM WERE DRIVING BACK TO THEIR BASE WHEN THEY SAW A LARGE, LUMINOUS OBJECT ABOVE SOME TREES.

THEY ALL DESCRIBED IT AS A GLOWING OBJECT WITH A GOLD/WHITE LIGHT. IT APPEARED SOLID WITH WINDOWS, THE SIZE BEING APPROX. FIFTEEN TO TWENTY FEET ACROSS. IT WAS CIRCULAR IN SHAPE LIKE TWO "PIE-PANS" PLACED TOGETHER WITH A SMALLER ROUND SHAPE ON THE TOP.

WALTON SUDDENLY JUMPED FROM THE WAGON AND RAN CLOSER TO THE OBJECT. HIS WORKMATES SHOUTED TO HIM TO COME BACK, THEN SUDDENLY A BLUE RAY FLASHED OUT FROM THE OBJECT AND WALTON FELL TO THE FLOOR.

DRIVEN BY FEAR, THE MEN DROVE TO TOWN AND RETURNED WITH THE POLICE. THERE WAS NO SIGN OF TRAVIS WALTON, DESPITE EXTENSIVE SEARCHES.

FIVE DAYS LATER, WALTON TURNED UP, RAGGED AND UNSHAVEN, OUTSIDE THE NEARBY TOWN OF SNOWFLAKE.

HIS STORY WAS ONE OF THE MOST BIZZARE, CONTROVERSIAL ABDUCTION CASES EVER TO BE TOLD, HE EVEN UNDERWENT A LIE-DETECTOR TEST, BUT FAR FROM ESTABLISHING THE TRUTH, THE VALIDITY OF THE TEST BECAME AN ISSUE ITSELF.
