

DATA-NET Report No. 3

March 23, 1967

DATA-NET started two months ago with two stations (WB6RPL-WB6QZD). In this short time it has grown to 22 members. (Roster included in this report.) DATA-NET operates without funds and we want to keep it strictly that way. However you must help with the postage. On the other aspects we have plenty of help, we have two secretaries, Susan and Claudette, access to copy reproducers, also help from persons attached to analytical laboratories.

3-12-67 We had a meeting with local members. We discussed moving to 75 meters, with the possibility of a clearer channel. No decision has been made awaiting the opinions of other members. The subject of large manila envelopes for mailing was considered too costly and dropped.

We had a sighting in the local bay area by WB6QZD (included in this report).

Double checking his story I interviewed three other witnesses, unknown to Paul, they confirmed the sighting as to location, duration, height (in relation to the horizon) color, lights, etc. This was also confirmed by Radio Station KSFO. The important thing here I think, is not so much if a UFO was sighted (it is still unidentified) but the conflicting explanations we received. The local airport said it was a weather balloon. Moffett Field, Navy air station, after much run around said it was a jet's after burner.

We now assume the jet went on it's merry way while the after-burner hovered for over an hour! Obviously both explanations cannot be correct. Unless of course both objects were in the same approximate area at the same time.

Personally I think it was probably a balloon, or a plane, or a star, high flying swamp gas, low flying insects, a turtle on LSD... all explanations are about as valid.

Recently I wrote about the man who fell from the sky and landed in a L.A. school yard. I now find that man is not alone. Many things fall from the sky. ("Impossible! Rocks do not fall from the sky!") Rain falls from the sky! White, blue, green, black, red and warm rain. Also blood fell from the sky. Snow; blue, black, green, and red snow. Sorry no warm snow.

Ice; not just sleet or hail but chunks weighing several pounds. recently a large cubicle chunk of ice fell thru someone's roof. The explanation was "probably from a plane". Report No. 180 of the CAA lists 68 U.F.O.'s, Aug. 13, 1952, over Washington D.C. all tracked on radar.

April 18, 1962, The Las Vegas Sun carried this story; An object landed beside an electric power station, putting it out for 40 minutes, it then took off, tracked on radar, pursued by our jets and finally exploded. It lit the area like the blast from an atomic explosion. The "official explanation" was; "giant fireball explodes over Nevada."

Feb.14, 1963 Denver, Colo. power blackout 1 hour 22 minutes. "apparently corrected itself", no explanations.

August 17, 1959. Brazil, Uberlandia. Same thing, this time U.F.O. seen by all technicians at power plant.

Mexico, Arizona, California, North east, Canada....same thing.

According to reports to dates, U.F.O.'s have visited every important communications center, industrial center and military center on Earth.

Professor Phylip Wylie asks why, if these things are real, they have never been tracked on radar or seen by astronomers? Now...Now... shall we go back to the teacher, the mule and the well?
