We wish to confirm it. Both on Friday and Saturday evening we saw a strange light in the sky, which at first we thought was a star of unusual magnitude. We, looking from Malvern North at 10 p.m., saw it rise in the direction of Mt. Dandenong. It rose about the same time on both evenings. Sometimes it burned red, then blue. It travelled towards the west. We also saw a similar light on Saturday and Sunday evening, at 7 p.m. It rose in the west, but soon disappeared.—Yours, &c.
