## STRANGE LIGHT.

### STEAMER MISLED OFF COAST.

When the R.M.S. Orontes, which arrived at Sydney yesterday morning, was about six miles south of the Heads a strange light was seen by some of the ship's officers. At first it was thought that the steamer was abreast of the Macquarie Light sooner than was expected, and the vessel was stopped. However, the position was examined, and whilst the strange light which flashed again and again, was being watched the real light was noticed ahead. The ship's officers are considerably puzzled about the matter, and it is proposed to report the occurrence to the navigation authorities.
