

LIGHT IN SKY

DROPS WITH STREAMING TAIL

LONDON, Saturday.

The passengers and crew of the steamer Mont Clare, bound for Liverpool, eagerly watched during the voyage for signs of Commander MacDonald. They reported a strange light in the sky astern at 6.30 o'clock on Thursday night, when the Mont Clare was 15 miles west of Tory Island, off the north-west coast of Ireland. The light was later seen to drop from the sky with a streaming tail.
