

Planes Guide Ghost Bombs

LONDON, Sept. 18 (Special).— Fairly good evidence now exists that at least some of the "ghost bombs" passing over Sweden are controlled by high-flying aircraft, says the News-Chronicle's Stockholm correspondent.

The Swedish General Staff has released news that a flying object was observed over central Sweden at a height of 1700ft. last Saturday, and the noise of a very high-flying unidentified aeroplane was heard simultaneously.

Military experts believe, the News-Chronicle correspondent says, that there was a definite connection between them.

Similar reports of high-flying aircraft and "flying objects" come from Denmark.

It has been officially stated that "a ball of fire" was seen passing over the Pinneberg district, in the British zone in Germany.
