

# FLASH OR SUPERMAN?

NEW YORK, October 15 (Special).—At least a dozen people at San Diego (on the south Californian coast) assert that they saw a "space-ship" from another comet flying over their town last Wednesday night.

According to the Los Angeles Daily News, they testify that they saw "a large weird object, shaped like a bullet with wings."

The authorities are sceptical, and claim that what these people saw was the Giacobini-Zinner comet (which is now being observed at some places in the Northern Hemisphere).

But the "space-ship" theorists

are supported in their view by a medium hired by the editor of the publication, Occult, to contact the strange visitant.

After a swift check-up, the medium delivered a finding that it was "a space-ship named Careeta from an unidentified planet," adding: "It did not land because the occupants were afraid of the reception they would get."
