

JAPANESE SEES "FLYING SAUCER"

TOKYO, Friday (A.A.P.): "Flying saucers" have now been reported over Japan.

A police officer at Kagoshima, in Southern Honshu, where the Allied invasion of Japan would have occurred in 1945 if the Japanese had not surrendered, said that while on duty shortly after midnight on the morning of July 9, he saw some hyphen-shaped brilliant objects flying over Kagoshima Bay, in a wave-like manner.

The objects were flying northeast at a height of about 3000ft.
