

"FLYING SAUCERS" SEEN BY JAP POLICEMAN

TOKYO, Friday.

"Flying saucers" have now appeared over Japan. The first flight was reported by a police officer at Kagoshima, in Southern Kyushu, where the Allied invasion was to have occurred in 1945.

The police officer, Shigeru Arrifuku, said that, while on duty shortly after midnight on July 9, he saw some brilliant objects flying over Kagosima Bay in a wave-like manner. The objects were flying northwest at about 3,000 feet.

The Kagoshima Weather Bureau declared that the "saucers," seen by the policeman, might have been balloons released by the Bureau after midnight.
