

SYDNEY TEST ON "FLYING SAUCERS"

A "flying saucer" sequence by Herald Cinesound cameramen on their daily rounds is the feature of interest in this week's news-reels. From lunch-time experiments in a Sydney park, a scientist has an explanation to offer of the strange reports from overseas.
