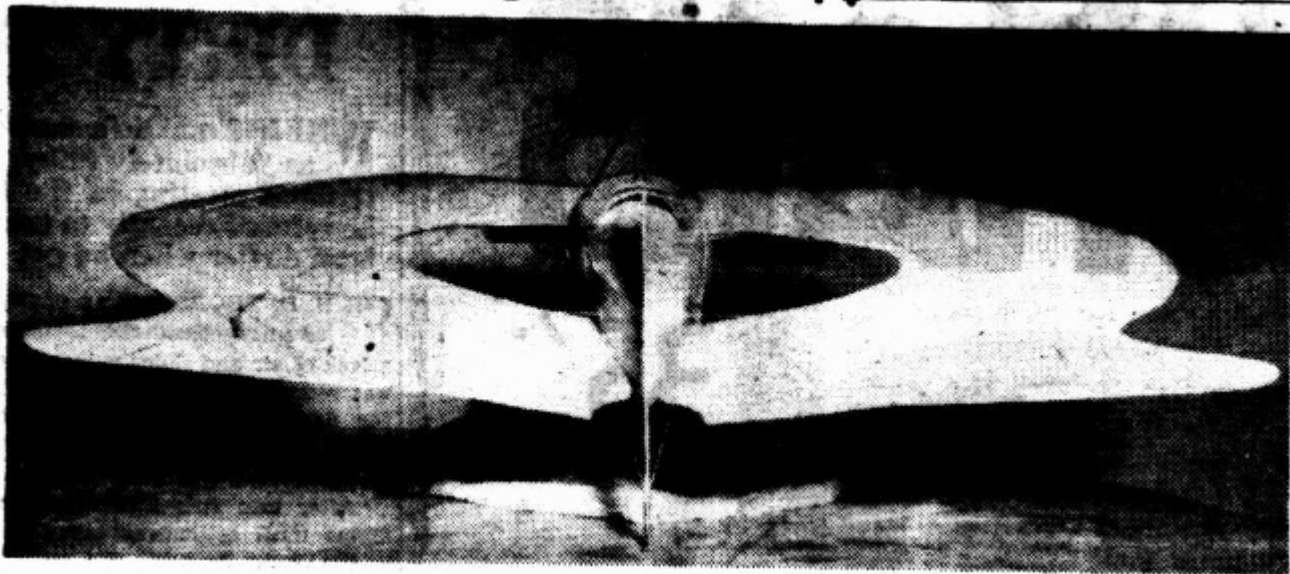


## Britain's "Flying Saucer"



**Model of Britain's own "Flying Saucer." The plane which cost £17,000 to build, flew 11,000 miles in tests. The designer, Mr G. T. Richards, does not know whether anyone has been experimenting secretly with his design. First tests of the plane were made in 1912. The designer has submitted his plans to the Royal Aeronautical Society and only this model of it remains now in the South Kensington Museum, London.**
