

UNIDENTIFIED MISSILE

EL PASO (Texas), Oct. 13.
—An unidentified projectile soared across the Texas-Mexico border yesterday and, after passing over Guadalupe (Mexico), exploded in the mountains beyond the city. The object, which may have been a rocket or robot bomb, was described as "black and cigar-shaped, about 5ft. long and 3ft. in diameter." The United States Army has begun an inquiry in an effort to solve the mystery of its origin. Officers at the White Sands proving grounds in New Mexico, and other installations in the south-west, said that no guided missiles had been fired yesterday.
