

Flying Saucer On Job Again

Fort Knox (Kentucky).
Thursday.—Flying saucers are rearing their ugly heads again.

An object spotted by Col. Guy Hix, commander of Goodman Field, was chased by planes and followed from the ground by State highway patrolmen.

Col. Hix said he spotted the saucer from the airport's observation tower. It was "very white and looked like an umbrella."

Planes trying to follow the object reported it was at 20,000 ft. when it disappeared. They estimated the object's speed at 180 m.p.h.

Highway patrol headquarters at Elizabeth Town reported having received calls from people who said they saw a flying disc resembling "an ice cream cone with a little fire at the bottom."—"News" Special
