

# **“Flying Saucer?”**

## **SEEN IN PERTH**

Perth, Feb. 6.—Accompanied by a roaring noise, similar to that made by a giant bull-roarer, a fiery visitor swept across the city and suburbs at a low altitude to-night and disappeared in the direction of the sea. The visitor was seen from many places, including hotel gardens, but the witnesses were in every instance quite sober.

Those who saw it described it as having a red coloured head about the size of a football, but not quite as oval, with a short tail, rosy in colour near the head and tapering to a yellowy green. It appeared to come in from an easterly direction and one observer, who had lengthy air force experience, estimated its height at between 3000 and 5000 ft. When he first saw it, it seemed to be travelling at a speed of 150 miles per hour and was emitting a deep roaring noise which, in some cases, was the first indication of its presence. As it moved westwards about 9 o'clock it seemed to be losing height rapidly and there was some doubt whether, at the speed it was falling it would reach

speed it was falling, it would reach as far as the ocean. One Malcolm street resident reported that it disappeared from vision near the Observatory.
