

## MORE MYSTERY AIR OBJECTS SEEN

WASHINGTON, July 25. — The flying saucer era may have returned to the United States.

Two civil aeronautics administration employees and a farmer reported to-day they saw a "silvery moonsized object" floating through the air over the city just after mid-day and again at 4 p.m. local time.

"It could not have been a weather balloon because it was floating up-wind. It was flying low, and seemed to have flashing lights," they said.

Meanwhile, at Atlanta (Georgia), two pilots who claimed yesterday they saw a huge flame shooting "Speed Gordon" type of sky monster while flying over Alabama, stoutly maintained to-day it was a "man made gadget."

They described it as a "wingless affair with a circumference four times that of a Super Fortress fuselage. It was definitely jet-propelled and had two rows of windows, each about the size of ordinary house windows."

The pilots say that they will be flying along the route again this evening and will take still and movie cameras in case the mystery monster appears.

PORTLAND (Oregon), July 25.— A Portland resident reported to-day he saw a big round bright object going west. It suddenly veered south-west "in an awful hurry." It bore no resemblance to aircraft and was roundish like a disc.

Two other airline crews in the Southern United States now report that they saw "streaks of light" during Friday night.

The pilot of one aircraft said that he was near Blackstone (Virginia) at the time and the pilot of the other said he was near Washington (D.C.).

"The times of the sightings indicate that all three crews may have seen the same thing," said one of the pilots.

Later, hundreds of people telephoned the civil aeronautics administration offices, reporting that they had seen a "moonsized blob" wheeling across the sky above the city.
