

Outmanoeuvred By "Flying Saucer"

NEW YORK, Oct. 3. A.A.P.—
"Flying saucers" again made front-page stories in Sunday papers with a report from a National Guard pilot that he had a half-hour encounter with an illuminated disc over North Dakota on Friday night.

In a statement to Air Force Intelligence, the pilot, who was flying an F51 fighter, said he encountered the disc at 4500ft.

It outran and outmanoeuvred him until he lost it at 17,500ft.

The performance was watched by two control-tower operators and the pilot of another plane.
