

Denmark Sees Flying Saucers

LONDON, November 22 (A.A.P.). — "Flying saucers" were reported to-day over Denmark.

The Copenhagen correspondent of American Associated Press says a coastguard at Skagen, North Jutland, reported having seen a flying disc hurtling northwards and leaving a white column of smoke behind it.

He saw another and watched it through binoculars.

The coastguard believes the objects were remote-controlled rockets.

The keeper of Skagen lighthouse and others also said they saw the discs.

[In July, 1947, hundreds of people in America and Canada reported "flying saucers." Many explanations were offered, including a theory by Professor F. S. Cotton, of Sydney, that they were seen when red corpuscles passed in front of the retina of the eye.]
