**D**ISCOVERY of two strange, dilapidated aircraft in an abandoned barn near Baltimore is said to have solved the mystery of America's flying saucers.

The flying saucers, unidentified aircraft, made their appearance in American skies in the last two years, baffling aviation experts and laymen.

**An Air Force officer said today the two aircraft were the prototypes of the flying saucers.**
