

Fantastic Story—Little Man On Flying Saucer

LOS ANGELES, Friday.—Los Angeles businessman Ray Dimmick told reporters here that he saw an ultra-streamlined flying saucer, last week, which had been wrecked on a mountainside in Mexico.

He added that he had been told that a man 23 inches tall died in the crash, that the body had been embalmed for scientific study and that high Mexican officials believed the machine came from some other planet. He said the saucer was powered by two motors.

It was described as being 46 feet in diameter and "built of a strange material like aluminium."

When high U.S. Air Force officials said they had not heard of the affair, Dimmick said: "I am big enough to take the consequence of what I have said, and I will stand my ground. I think the Government should make the position clear.

"If it does not want to disclose this thing for security reasons, why not say so?"
