

FANTASTIC FLYING SAUCER TALE

“Midget Man” In Mexico

Mountain Crash

NEW YORK, Friday.

A Los Angeles business man, Ray Dimmick, told reporters that he saw an ultra-streamlined flying saucer last week which had been wrecked on the side of a mountain in Mexico.

He added that he had been told that a man 23 inches tall had died in the crash and that the body had been embalmed for scientific study and that high Mexican officials believed the machine came from some other planet.

Dimmick said that the crash occurred about three months ago. He had been taken to the scene of the crash by business associates. The saucer was powered by two motors and was about 46 feet in diameter and built of a strange material resembling aluminium.

Dimmick said: "I am big enough to take the consequences |

ough to take the consequences of what I have said and to stand my ground.

"I think the Government ought to make its position clear: If it does not want to disclose these things for security reasons why not say so."

The Associated Press says that Dimmick later changed his story and said he saw only a strip of metal which business

associates told him had come from a space ship. He was told that the wreckage was on a mountain side in Mexico and that leading military officials of the United States had viewed it.

Dimmick said he could furnish names of the business associates if requested to do so by the proper authorities.

He added that some United States military officials had viewed the crash.

NO CONFIRMATION

The Associated Press says there is no confirmation of Dimmick's story in Mexico and the Air Force in Washington said that they had not heard of the matter.

According to Reuter's Mexico correspondent the Mexican Government put an end to the flying saucer scare by announcing that there was no real basis for reports that flying saucers had been seen over Mexico. They had been reported over Tihuahua airport and also over Durango City.

The flying saucer over Durango City had remained overhead for two hours, according to persons who claimed to have seen it.

A military officer who reported it over the airports says now that what he really saw was the planet Venus.
