

"Flying saucer" latest: it dives, loops, zips

NEW YORK, Tues. (S.S.) : Residents of California have reported a "flying saucer" that dived near a motor-car, looped the loop, and zipped across the horizon.

It happened on Saturday night, according to Mrs. S. Raguindin, who said the "saucer" looked like two dinner plates placed together as it swooped near her car

She was one of a score of people who told the sheriff at Salinas of a curious, bright object in the sky.

Mrs. Raguindin said it came down to what seemed 2,000 feet and gave off a bluish light like a welder's torch as it came closer.

Mr. Hiram Don told the sheriff a "bright object in the sky had a fiery tail and was travelling quite close to the ground."

Dr. Olin Eggen, astronomer at the University of California, speculated that the object might

speculated that the object might have been a large meteor.

In Los Angeles Miss Betty Malles took a snapshot of a disc-like object she saw in the sky at sunset.

The developed film shows a strange luminous oblong "doughnut," with a dark center suggesting a hole. She has passed the negative to scientists for study.
