

U.S. Air Force Decries Flying Saucer Reports

WASHINGTON, March 19. A.A.P.—Despite many recent reports of "seeing" flying saucers, a spokesman for the American Air Force said to-day it still believed there was no such thing.

He added that Air Force Intelligence and technical officers were not impressed by the latest reports of flying discs.

New accounts of flying saucers came in to-day from Ravana, Mexico City, New Mexico and even Turkey.

The spokesman denied categorically that the Air Force was denying the existence of flying saucers to cover up some of its own experiments in space ships and similar air machines.

He said the Air Force position still was that saucer reports were a "misinterpretation of conventional objects, a mild form of mass hysteria or hoaxes."
