

Flying Saucer Reports Called Hysteria

WASHINGTON, Sunday.

Despite many recent reports of "seeing" flying saucers, a spokesman for the American Air Force said yesterday that it still believes there is no such thing.

He added that air force intelligence and technical officers were not impressed by the latest reports of flying disks.

The new account of flying saucers came from Havana, Mexico City, New Mexico and even Turkey.

A spokesman denied categorically that the air force was denying the existence of flying saucers to cover up some of its own experiments in space ships and similar air machines.

He said that the air force position still is that saucer reports were a misrepresentation of conventional objects, a mild form of mass hysteria or hoaxes.
