

# Saucer was 'test' plane

NEW YORK, Wed. —

Two American airline pilots who reported having seen a "flying saucer" over Arkansas on Monday night said they believed it was a secret experimental type of aircraft.

They are Captain Jack Adams and his co-pilot, First Lieutenant G. Anderson, of Chicago Southern Airlines.

They said yesterday they saw the saucer while flying over Stuttgart, Arkansas.

Adams said: "It was about 1000 feet above us and traveling at 500 to 600 miles an hour.

"We watched it for about 45 seconds, when it vanished from sight, presumably because it was going so fast.

"I could tell it was circular

"On top it had a peculiar colored light which blinked rapidly."
