

# "FLYING SAUCER HAD WINDOWS"

**M**EMPHIS (Tennessee), Wed. — A flying saucer with windows at the bottom and a blinking light on top flew over Arkansas on Monday night at tremendous speed, two airline pilots reported yesterday.

**T**HE United States Air Force, which previously announced it would have nothing more to do with flying saucer reports, sent intelligence officers to interview the pilots, Capt. J. Adams and First Officer G. Anderson.

Mrs. Eleanor Roosevelt has invited them to appear on her New York television programme on Sunday.

## "Not From Space"

Capt. Adams said: "We firmly believe the flying saucer we saw was a secret experimental type of aircraft — not a visitor from outer space.

"We are certain it was not a meteor.

"It was an aircraft in controlled flight.

"There were no navigation lights,

but lights from eight or 10 windows could be seen plainly on the lower side as it passed ahead of us.

"A strong blue-white light was flashing very rapidly on top.

"The object seemed to be about the size of a DC3 Dakota.

"Anderson and I had read about flying saucers and we were as sceptical as most people.

"But what can you do but believe your eyes."
