

Flying Saucer Reported Seen In Arkansas

MEMPHIS (Tennessee) March 21.—A flying saucer with windows at the bottom and "a blinking light" on top flew over Arkansas to-night at tremendous speed, two airline pilots reported to-day.

The United States Air Force, which previously announced it would have nothing to do with flying saucers sent intelligence officers to interview Captain Jack Adams and First Officer G. Anderson, and Mrs. Eleanor Roosevelt invited them to appear on her New York television programme on March 26.

The pilots plan to build a model of the strange craft and have it televised.

Adams said: "We firmly believe the flying saucer we saw was a secret experimental type of aircraft—not a visitor from the outer space—we are certain it was not a meteor. It was an aircraft in controlled flight."

LISBON, March 22.—Scores of flying saucers have been reported by coastguards off the North Portugal coast flying in line and other formation.

Coastguards said they were moving west "faster than tracer bullets."

A number of persons in Oporto Douro also claim to have seen "fireballs."

"We were flying at 2000 feet when we noticed an intense blinking light about half a mile away.

"It was a circular object zooming along at 500 to 600 miles an hour in a wide arc. It remained in view for about 30 seconds. There were no navigation lights, but lights from eight or ten windows could be plainly seen on the lower side as it passed ahead of us. A strong blue and white light was flashing very rapidly on the top. The object seemed to be about the size of a DC 3 Dakota. There wasn't any exhaust or vapour trail" Anderson said.

"I had read about flying saucers, but we were as sceptical as most people, but what can you do but believe your eyes."
