

NEW INTEREST IN "SAUCERS"

NEW YORK, March 26 (A.A.P.): Mrs. Eleanor Roosevelt today said she was impressed by a report of a "flying saucer" from two veteran airline pilots.

She interviewed Captain Jack Adams and First Officer G. Anderson on her weekly television programme.

They had caused a stir by declaring that they had sighted "a strange circular craft with blinking lights" speeding over Arkansas on Monday night.

Mrs. Roosevelt said she had thought that people who reported flying saucers were "seeing things" until she heard the pilots' story. She described it as "evidence that we have not heard before—from qualified people."

Mrs. Roosevelt asked Captain Adams whether he thought people were aboard the saucer. "I don't know, but I am positive it was controlled flight," he replied.

A scale model of the weird craft fitting the pilots' description was televised. It was shaped like a Chinese coolie hat with one large light at its pointed top and other lights spaced around the brim.
