

New Evidence On "Flying Saucer"

NEW YORK, Monday.—Eleanor Roosevelt said yesterday she was impressed by the report of a "flying saucer" from two veteran airline pilots.

She had interviewed Captain Jack Adams and First Officer G. Anderson on her weekly television programme.

They had caused a stir by declaring they sighted a "strange circular craft with blinking lights" speeding over Arkansas last Monday night.

Mrs. Roosevelt said she had thought people who reported

flying saucers were "seeing things" until she heard the pilot's story.

She described it as "evidence we have not heard before—from qualified people."
