

New U.S. Report Of Flying Saucer

WASHINGTON, March 27 (A.A.P.).—A veteran private pilot said yesterday that he saw a flying saucer within 25 miles of Washington.

The pilot, Mr. Bertram Totten, is a clerk at the Congressional Library.

He said that he was flying at 5,000ft when he sighted an aluminium-coloured disc, about 40ft wide and 10ft thick, whirling along 1,000ft below his plane.

The saucer gave off vapour trails like those from aircraft engines.

In New York yesterday Mrs. Eleanor Roosevelt said she was impressed by the report of a flying saucer from two veteran airline pilots.

On her weekly television programme, she interviewed the two pilots, Captain Jack Adams and First Officer G. Anderson, who caused a stir last week when they reported that they had seen a strange circular craft with blinking lights speeding over Arkansas.

Mrs. Roosevelt said that the pilots' story was "evidence we have not heard before—from qualified people."
