

## **No flying saucers over Britain yet**

LONDON, Sunday.—  
Telephones buzzed to the British Air Ministry today reporting a "flying saucer" over London.

For half an hour watchers saw clearly a high-riding object glinting in the sunshine between the April clouds.

The Air Ministry explained it was a balloon used for parachute jumping which had broken from its moorings in Oxfordshire.

Accordingly, the first flying saucer is yet to be seen over Britain, although there have been numerous recent reports that they are visible in various parts of the Continent. Belgian newspapers have been printing speculative articles suggesting they are "space-ships" or reconnoitring discs from some other part of the universe.
