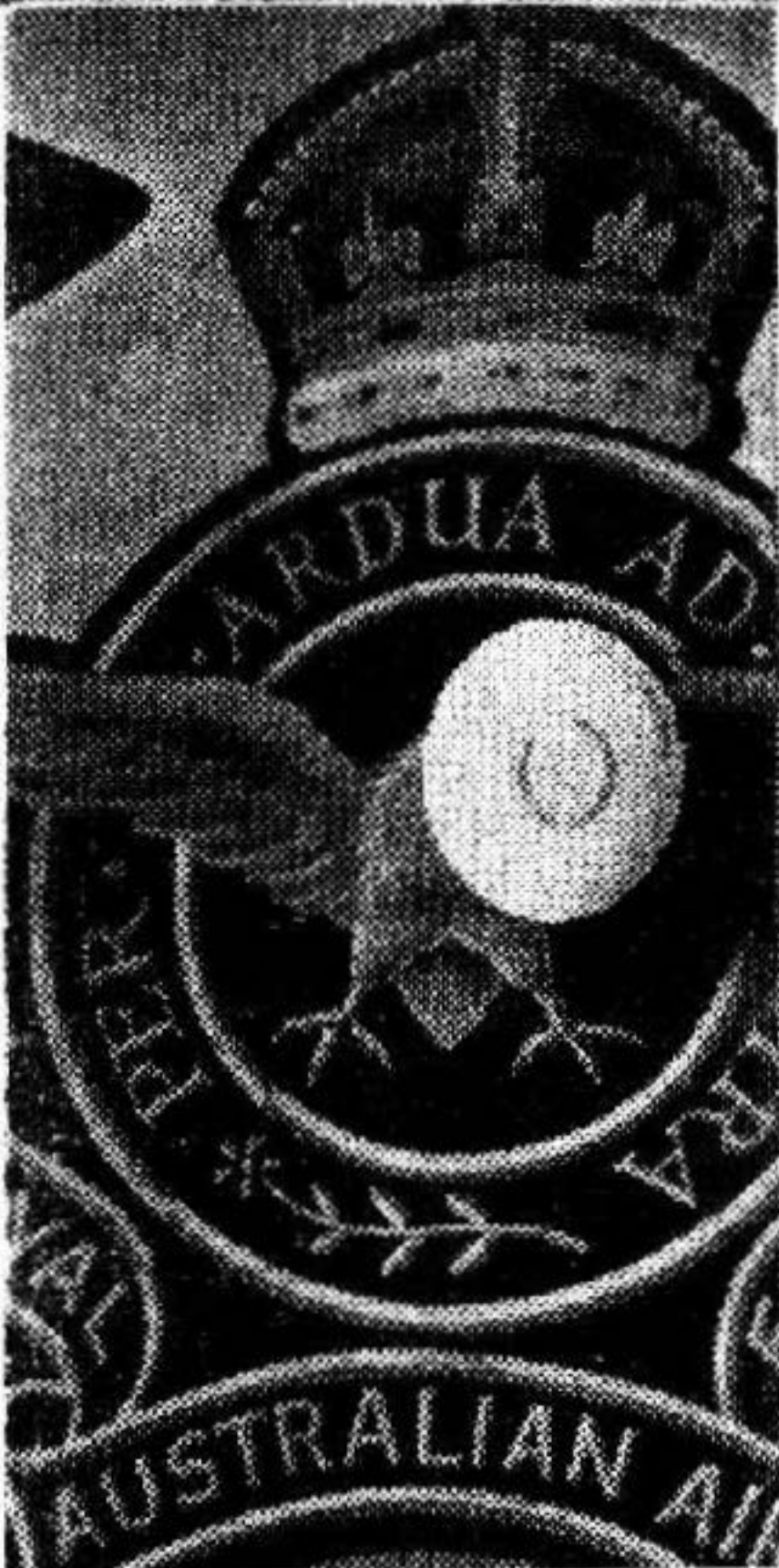
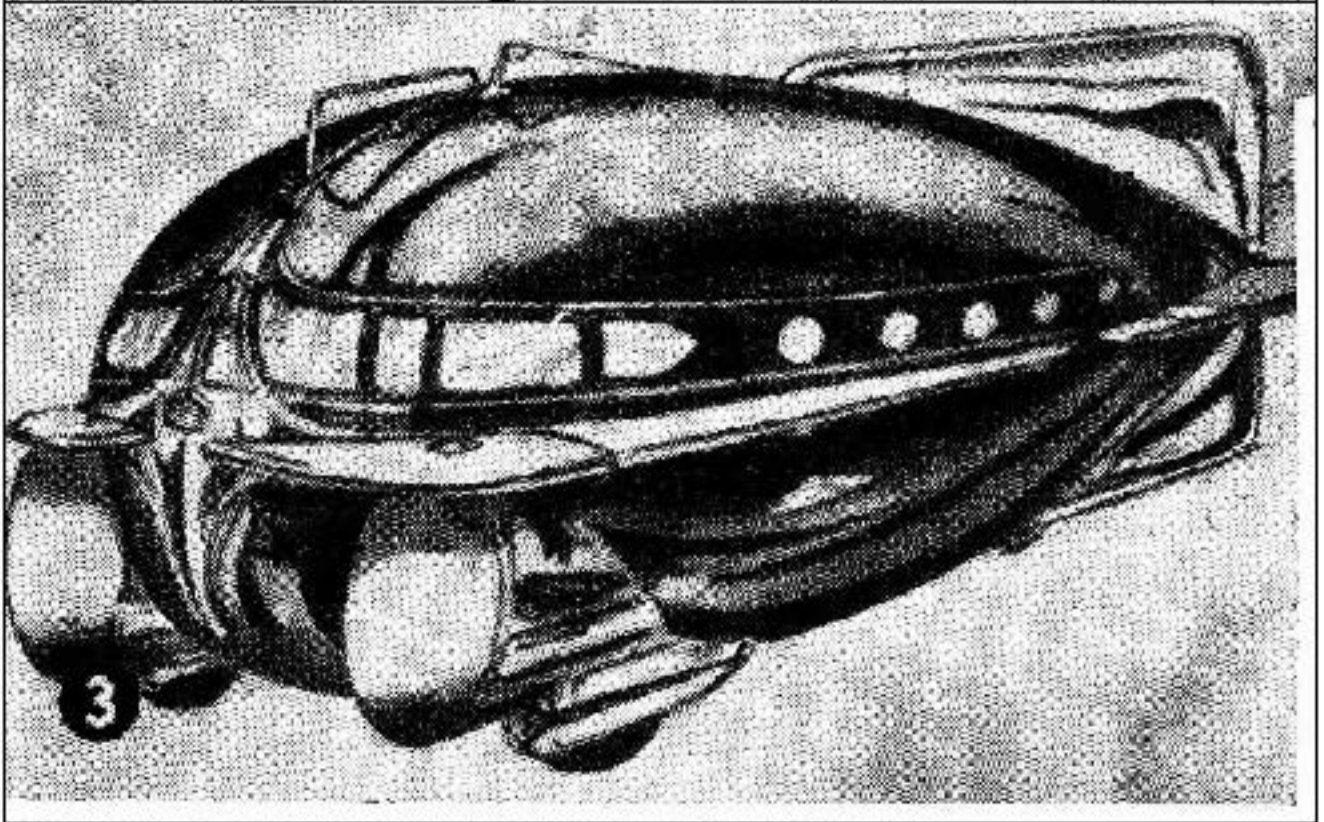
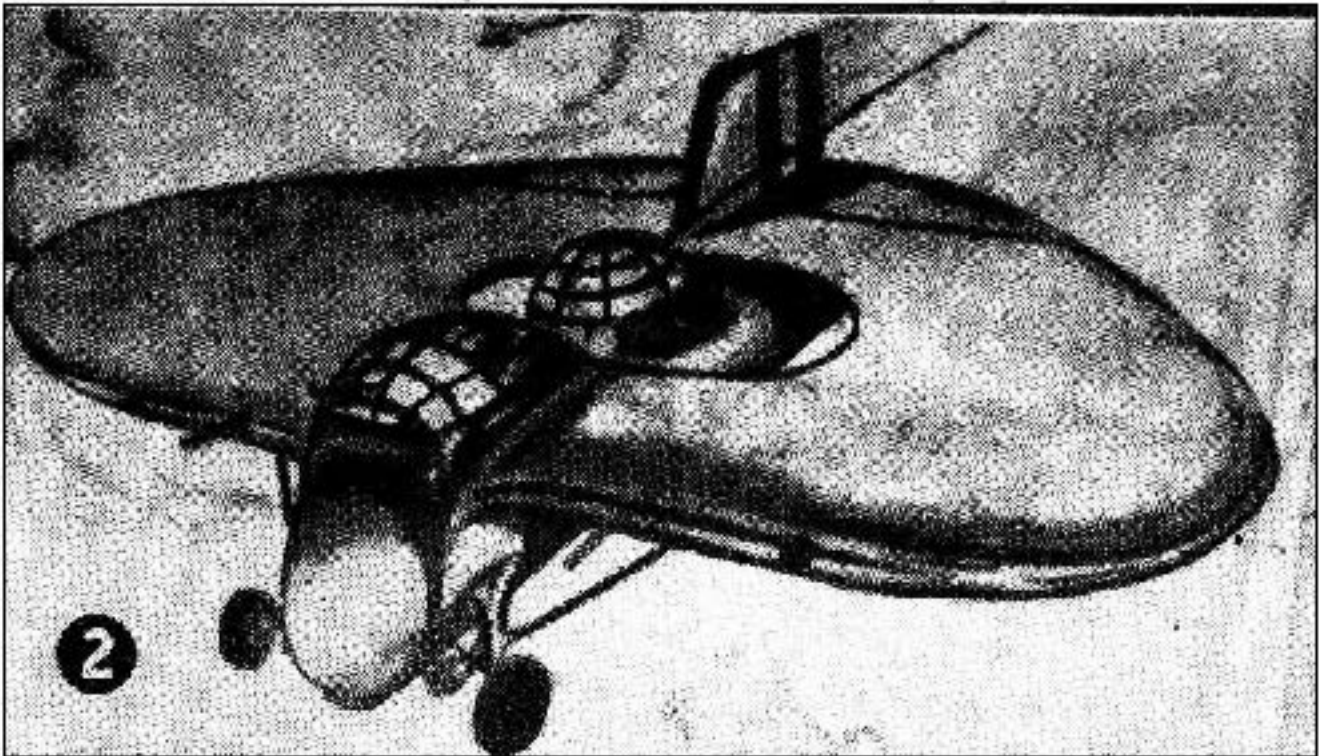


Flying Saucers were here 20 years ago
