

"FLYING SAUCERS" IN NEW ZEALAND!

The "flying saucer" craze has reached New Zealand.

According to reports people there have seen some of the mystery birds of passage.

A man at Wairoa, 250 miles north of Wellington, and a woman at Palmerston North, both claim to have seen a saucer, about half the size of the moon moving north-east on Thursday night. Both insist that it neither a meteor nor an aircraft.

Two Wellington men declare that "in the cold light of sobriety" they saw a flying saucer at 11 p.m. on Thursday. It was flying very high, had a winking orange tail-light and was visible for three minutes.

Walter Withers, 62, described as a teetotaller, now declares he saw a 30ft.-long row of lighted portholes on a moonless night nine months ago. It was travelling east at a moderate pace, but the shape of the object was indistinguishable.
