

# More W.A. stories of saucers

**Perth.—More and more people are coming forward with claims to have seen a flying saucer or saucers over Perth on Monday night.**

They are emphatic the object was not an aircraft or meteor.

One description was that it was "an orange light which passed across the sky very high and very fast."

Another referred to the object as being "about 20 ft. in diameter, orange in color, and going round and round about 1,000 ft. above Fremantle Harbor."

Yet another version was that it was "a fairly large circle or ball, pale blue in

color with a tail gradually thinning out at the end."

Flying men consider the cause of all this speculation may have been a DC3 airliner circling the city on arrival from Darwin.

The Weather Bureau said they released no balloons that could have been mistaken for flying saucers at the time people say they saw the object.
