

More Local Testimony

Another witness of Monday night's so-called flying saucer has asserted that whatever was seen "could not possibly have been an aircraft."

Mrs. D. Bates, of Leslie-st., Mandurah said that she was with a friend at an open-air theatre at Mandurah on Monday night when they and many others in the theatre saw "what appeared to be a comet" flash across the sky.

It happened shortly after the interval. (This time coincides with the time it was seen by other witnesses).

Railway fireman H. K. Fowles and train driver L. O'Dea saw the occurrence at Venn — a siding about 46 miles from Perth.

Government Astronomer H. Spigl said that from their description the object they saw was a meteorite.
