

# FLYING SAUCER SPECULATION

MIAMI BEACH, April 25—  
Mr. Kenneth de Courcy, editor  
of the "London Intelligence  
Digest", today said he believed  
flying saucers were spent cart-  
ridges of guided missiles.

Mr. de Courcy gained inter-  
national attention when he re-  
ported that Russia had the  
atom bomb long before Pre-  
sident Truman announced  
there had been an atomic ex-  
plosion in the Soviet Union.

Mr. de Courcy, who is now  
touring the United States,  
said Russia already had out-  
stripped the United States in  
the development of submarine  
power.

He thought the Russians  
would use submarines to carry  
atom bombs in the event of  
war and would probably ex-  
plode them under water.

The world would pass  
through the greatest crisis in  
history during the next two  
years, said Mr. de Courcy. He  
urged the Western Powers to  
concentrate on building up  
Turkey and the Near East in
