

FLYING SAUCER OVER AIRPORT

VANCOUVER, April 27.

International airport officials reported to-night they saw an "object about 200 feet long and shaped like an ice-cream cone" flash over an airport at tremendous speed.

Mr. F. Magar, Superintendent of Airport Operations, said: "I've never seen anything like it before. I've never turned in a report about flying saucers either."

He said a white substance hung about the tail but did not cloud over as vapour did from a fast-moving plane.

"It might have been doing at least 700 miles an hour," said Mr. Magar, who added he had checked with air traffic control and had been informed no aircraft were scheduled in the area at that time.
