

# FLYING SAUCER

Kansas City, Today: A flying saucer dogged an airliner today. Veteran pilot Capt. Robert Adickes said it was a "glowing cherry red."

Nineteen passengers and the crew of the airliner watched the object, which kept about half a mile away, for at least 5 minutes. Adickes of sight. I estimated it was mechanical device.

"It appeared to be controlled by repulse radar," he said. "As I would turn towards it, it would veer away, keeping the same distance.

"When I turned directly at it, it took off at about 400 m.p.h. That was twice my speed.

"It went down from 2000 to 1500 feet, then streaked out of sight. It was hard to judge its size.

"I estimated it was between 20 and 30 feet in diameter and about 10 p.c. as thick as it was in diameter."
