

## **"FLYING SAUCER" SEEN NEAR TUMUT**

### **"Like the Top of a Mushroom"**

Mr. and Mrs. L. H. Anderson, of Tumut, saw a flying saucer whilst driving along the Brungle road towards Tumut.

It was about 25 to 30 feet in diameter, 8 feet high, and was shaped like the top of a mushroom. It had no doors or windows, and was not spinning around.
