

ANOTHER FLYING SAUCER

Aircrew Near
Sydney

SYDNEY, Friday — A strange object in the sky was seen by the crew of a DC3 airfreighter about 30 miles from Sydney last night.

Captain Gordon Savage and First Officer Frank Hastlow, both of Melbourne, said it could have been a "flying saucer."

The plane was flying at 8000 feet, and Savage said that the strange light was seen about 2000 feet below the aircraft.

Savage added: "Thinking the light could have been a navigation light of a plane, we contacted Mascot aerodrome, but were assured that there were no planes in the vicinity.

"When we attempted to approach it, it seemed to vanish in a protective mist so that it appeared as a dull white glow.

"At this time there was no natural mist or fog about.

"When we switched our navigation lights on, it came into

full view. It was a definite object. I am certain of this, although I could not distinguish its shape."
