

"FLYING SAUCER" MYSTERY SOLVED

SYDNEY, Friday.—The mystery of the "flying saucers" may have been solved by a trans-Australia airlines pilot who saw a "saucer" about 30 miles south east of Sydney early today.

The pilot, Captain Gordon Savage, believes the "saucer" he saw was an illusion created by the planet Venus rising above the horizon.

Professor of Physics at Sydney University, Professor Love, said Captain Savage's theory might be the explanation of flying saucers.

"Captain Savage's description not only tallies perfectly with Venus, but also with most other planets," he said.

The Government Astronomer (Mr. Wood) commented "Captain Savage has no doubt given a correct and level headed explanation of the saucer."

Mr. Wood said Venus could be seen anywhere either at night or in the daytime.

The Civil Aviation Department and the R.A.A.F. are investigating his report of seeing "a very bright light alternating in colour from red to white at 15 second intervals."
