

'Saucer' Reported Near Lismore

LISMORE.—Residents of Swan Bay, near Lismore, are puzzled by an object which appeared in the sky over the town early this morning. They believe it is a flying saucer.

It is the fifth occasion that the object has been seen in the past two weeks.

Mr. N. York, a Swan Bay engineer, said that the object was about the size of a football and shone with a bright light. It disappeared rapidly towards the north-west.

A number of other people in the district have seen it and have described it as a shining object, but have been unable to give any further description.

The Sydney Observatory has not received any report of this object from Lismore, although one or two reports of shining objects have been received from Sydney suburbs.

One was reported flying over Five Dock yesterday afternoon and another over Beecroft on Wednesday night.

These reports have not been established as genuine.
