

FLYING SAUCER IN ACTION

A BOUT 40 models, including a "flying saucer" and jets, were seen in action at a Model Aero Club display at Hobart yesterday.

The display was staged by the West Hobart Model Aero Club.

"The "flying saucer" was about a foot in diameter.

Outstanding model was a jet built by David Reynolds. In two flights it reached speeds of 90 and 95 m.p.h., and was the first jet model to be flown in Tasmania. It was copied from an American model which holds the world speed record of 159 m.p.h.

The models used yesterday were controlled by wires from the ground.
