

PICTURES OF "FLYING SAUCER"

NEW YORK, Monday.—Three pictures purporting to show a "flying saucer" in action were published today by the New York Journal-American, which said that the photographs were taken by a farmer as a "saucer" zipped over his barn near Dayton, Oregon.

One of the pictures depicted a dome-like object in the sky. Another gave a close-up side view. The third showed the under side of the object.

The pictures were captioned: "Do saucers fly? Farmer's photos answer 'Yes'."
