

Saucer's "roar like thunder

Los Angeles, Wednesday.—
A flying saucer, "roaring like
thunder at more than 1,000
m.p.h.," was reported early
today at Oakland (Calif-
ornia).

Three control tower officers
said a disc-shaped object
dived five times over Hamil-
ton Air Force base, after
approaching at altitudes be-
tween 2,000 and 5,000 ft.,
shooting blue flame.

The men said they followed
the disc's course with bino-
culars.

Corporal Roger Pryor com-
mented, "At first I thought it
was a falling star, but it
didn't fall. It kept on going."
