

## "FLYING SAUCER" IN DISPLAY

NEW YORK: Three control tower officials at Hamilton Air Force Base, California, yesterday reported a "flying saucer."

They said that a "disc-shaped object" dived five times over the base, approaching it at altitudes of between 2000 and 5000 feet, shooting a blue flame.

The men said they followed the disc's course with binoculars.

One of them, Corporal Roger Pryor, said: "At first I thought it was a falling star, but it didn't fall. It kept on going."

U.S. Air Force Intelligence officers questioned the three tower officers all the morning.

Headquarters of the Fourth Air Force at Hamilton Field would not comment. They said that a report was being sent to Washington.

The three men said at a Press conference that they could not discern the exact shape of the object, and they heard no sound.
