

## **FLYING SAUCER OVER 1000 M.P.H.**

A flying saucer, roaring like thunder at over 1000 miles an hour, was reported today. Three control tower officers said the disc-shaped object dived five times over Hamilton Air Force base in an approach between 2000 and 5000 feet, flying a blue flag.
