

# "FLYING SAUCER" SEEN AT QUEENSTOWN

**S**EVERAL Queenstown residents claim to have seen on Tuesday night an object corresponding to descriptions of a "flying saucer."

**M**R. R. DELANEY said he timed its appearance, at 8.3 p.m.

It appeared from the direction of Strahan, travelling eastward at a terrific speed.

It was visible for about 12s. before being obscured by Mt. Owen.

The object was disc shape, and emitted a bright glow which fluctuated in intensity.

Mr. J. Triptree said he thought the object was a falling star.

It appeared to revolve, throwing a stream of fire from its tail once each revolution.

His description of the time and flight of the object tallied very closely with that given by Mr. Delaney.

A shooting star, which was reported to have been seen from the south-eastern corner of King Island about 8 p.m. on Tuesday, was seen also at Burnie by Messrs. E. Swain, A. Lynox, H. Cranwell, and L. Priest about the same time.

The men said they saw the star
