

# **"Saucer" Is Identified As Meteor**

**SYDNEY:** A "flying saucer," which more than a dozen people in two States said they saw on Wednesday, was identified in Sydney today by the Government Astronomer (Mr. Harley Wood) as a meteor.

"In fact," he said, "two of the descriptions we had of the saucer were the best we have ever had of a meteor."

The "flying saucer" was seen about 7 p.m. on Wednesday by persons in Brisbane, Glen Innes, Gladstone (N.S.W.) and in Homebush.

Mr. Harley Wood explained: "The meteor would be about 80 miles up, and travelling faster than 25 miles a second. That is the reason why it was seen over such a wide area."
